SEAWEEED SEZ

- The next time you fish with a plastic bait or curl-tail, try this.
- Take an Alka-Seltzer tablet and break it in to small pieces. Make a small slit in the thicker part of the body. Insert a piece of the tablet into this slit.
- As you fish, the bait will fizz and emit tiny bubbles. This action and sound will attract fish, especially when fishing in stained water
- Be different: have fun!
