Tournaments Rules Rev January, 2008

These rules apply to ALL MSC fishing events.

1. Events are open to MSC members only, unaccompanied by a guide or charter captain.
2. Rod and reel catches only. No assistance except in gaffing or netting the fish.
3. Local waters only: south to Chatham River and north to Clam Pass.
4. Fish must actually be measured.
5. The contest date for annual contests is from January 1 to December 31.
6. The longest fish of each listed species above the minimum is the winner. In the event of a tie, the first fish called in wins.
7. The Board of Directors may make changes to these rules. If so, they will be announced prior to the event.
